



# AOTEAROA CAFE GUIDE

## THE KOHA JAR PROJECT

An extra take on the Mug Library that works for for cafes or community markets. It's all about working with your wider community to reduce single use waste and connect with each other for goodness

## HOW IT WORKS

Contact your local schools or community groups (we can help with this stage). Ask them if they would like to fundraise for themselves via a **KohaJar Project** to be located at your cafe or market.

If they are keen, simply ask them to collect clean jars, you stipulate the size that best works for your coffee machines, and create a heat band by either adding a few rubber bands, or wrapping twine about the jar where it is to be held.

For markets, create a roster, so you know who is coming along when. Allocate an area where the group can set up a small table to display their **KohaJars**, and where a **Koha Jar** can be placed to receive any donations.

Either provide a table, or request that the groups provide their own.

For cafes, find an area, a shelf, a basket, a crate, where the jars can be displayed and a **Koha Jar** can be placed to receive any donations.
